Sealed proposals will be received by the Township Administrator for the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Caldwell on Thursday, April 17, 2025 at 11:00 AM, prevailing time, or soon after as the matter can be reached, in the office of the Township Administrator, Municipal Building, 30 Clinton Road, West Caldwell, New Jersey, for the following services for the calendar year 2025:

- Bond Counsel
- Engineering Services for Swimming Pool Investigation and Improvements

Requests for Proposals are available on the Township website www.westcaldwell.com as well as on file in the office of the Township Administrator, Municipal Building, 30 Clinton Road, West Caldwell, New Jersey, 07006, where same may be inspected during business hours beginning on Thursday, March 27, 2025.

Each proposal must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the proposer on the face of the envelope and clearly marked with the name of the service being submitted for consideration. Proposals must be submitted at the time and place above specified and will be opened and read thereafter. Proposals will be accepted by mail or in person at the time specified. No Proposal, either by mail or in person, will be accepted after the date and hour specified. In the case of mailed Proposals, the Township assumes no responsibility for bid proposals received after the date and time above specified.

The Mayor and Council reserve the right to waive any informalities and reject any and all proposals. Proposers shall comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 et seq.

All final awards shall be made by resolution adopted by a majority of the Mayor and Council based upon the proposals made to the Township that have been determined to be the most advantageous to the Township, all factors (price & other) considered.

1. INTRODUCTION

The Township of West Caldwell is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide design, bidding, and engineering services for the enhancement of the Westville Pool, located at 293 Westville Avenue in West Caldwell. The goal of this project is to upgrade existing facilities and introduce new amenities, ensuring that the pool area can serve the community year-round and provide an enjoyable and safe environment for all ages.

2. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The enhancements to the Westville Pool will include the following key components:

- **Upgrading Bathroom and Locker Facilities:** Renovating the current bathroom and locker areas to meet modern standards for accessibility, comfort, and efficiency.
- **Upgrading Concession Stand:** Improving the current concession stand area to offer better services for patrons, including any necessary electrical, plumbing, and structural modifications.
- **Addition of a Lap Pool (25m or 50m):** Constructing a new lap pool to serve competitive swimmers and recreational users. The pool should be designed with the option to accommodate either a 25-meter or 50-meter length, depending on further consultation.
- **Splash Pool for Younger Children:** Adding a separate, shallow splash pool/pad that is safe and engaging for young children.
- **Lap Pool Cover (Bubble):** A retractable bubble cover should be designed for the lap pool, ensuring the pool can be used throughout the year. The cover should be easy to install and remove, with the capacity to withstand seasonal conditions. In warmer months, the cover should be easily removable to ensure an open, outdoor experience.

The enhancements should aim to meet local zoning and building codes, adhere to safety and accessibility regulations, and consider environmental sustainability where possible.

3. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The firm selected will be required to deliver the following services:

A. Design Phase:

- Develop conceptual designs for an upgraded facility at the Westville Avenue site. Proposal shall include up to three (3) concept plans.
- Incorporate modern amenities and improvements, including but not limited to:
 1. Upgrades to the existing pool.

2. Upgraded bathroom and locker facilities.
 3. Renovated concession stand.
 4. Addition of a lap pool (25m or 50m option), with removable/retractable cover.
 5. Inclusion of a splash pad for younger children.
- Prepare detailed engineering designs, including structural, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems, as well as landscaping and site design as necessary.
 - Provide recommendations for the type of bubble cover for the lap pool, ensuring ease of use for seasonal transitions.
- B. Bidding Services:**
- Prepare bid documents and specifications in accordance with the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law.
 - Review bids and provide recommendations to the Township.
- C. Construction Management:**
- Provide ongoing support during construction, including field inspections, coordination with the contractor, and ensuring that the project is completed in accordance with the approved designs and specifications.
 - Conduct any necessary testing or evaluations during construction to ensure the quality of materials and workmanship.
 - Provide necessary support for obtaining all required permits and approvals from local authorities.
4. **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Proposers for Township Engineering Services shall meet the following minimum qualifications:
- a. Must be a licensed professional engineer in the State of New Jersey.
 - b. Must have at least ten (10) years experience as a licensed professional engineer.
 - c. Must have at least five (5) years experience in providing consulting services to municipalities, including demonstrated experience with road programs, drainage improvement projects, water and sewer infrastructure projects, utility upgrades and replacement, public building improvement programs, recreational facilities, land surveying and mapping projects.
 - e. Must be responsive to telephone calls and inquiries.
 - f. Must be able to handle diverse issues and matters.
5. **CONTRACT REQUIRED.** The successful proposer shall be required to execute the Township's form contract which includes its standard form indemnification and insurance provisions.

PROPOSER'S RESPONSIBILITY IN RESPONDING TO TOWNSHIP'S REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

In response to this RFP each proposer shall provide at a minimum the following information:

1. Qualification Information:

- a. Firm Name, Address and Telephone Number.
- b. Firm's specialties or areas of expertise.
- c. Proof of licensure.
- d. Cost proposal shall be a lump sum fee proposal covering all services outlined herein, including investigation of existing pools, design (with up to three concept variations), bidding and construction management services.
- e. A rate sheet that includes the hourly rate for all staff and professionals who may serve the account, for additional services.
- f. Dates of licensure in the State of New Jersey and any other state as to the professional discipline requested to serve the needs of the Township.
- g. A listing of professional affiliations or membership in any professional societies or organizations, with an indication as to any offices held.
- h. The number of employees and engineers employed and/or affiliated with the firm, and a listing of the name, school and year of graduation of all engineers/professionals and staff that will be providing services to the Township pursuant to this proposal.
- i. A listing of all previous public sector entities served by the proposer including dates of service and position(s) held.
- j. Any other relevant work experience that you would like the Township to consider in evaluating your qualifications.
- k. A listing of any and all ethics or disciplinary charges assessed against you and/or your Firm and the details surrounding same including the disposition of the charge(s).
- l. The name, address and telephone number of three client references that can be contacted by the Township for similar projects.
- m. Any additional information that you would like the Township to consider in evaluating your proposal.

2. Insurance. The proposer, as a member of a profession that is subject to suit for professional malpractice, shall provide documentation that insurance for professional liability/malpractice coverage with limits as to liability that will be in place to protect the Township of West Caldwell. If appointed, proposer shall furnish a certificate of insurance naming the Township of West Caldwell as an additional insured under such policies.

3. Law Against Discrimination and Affirmative Action. The proposer shall file a statement as to compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:5-1 et seq. (Laws against Discrimination) and P.L. 1975, c. 127 (Affirmative Action).

4. Proof of Business Registration Certificate. Proposer must furnish a copy of their New Jersey Business Registration Certificate prior to award of contract as required by N.J.S.A. 52:32-44.

5. **Ownership Disclosure Form.** Proposer must complete and submit the Ownership Disclosure Form attached hereto as Exhibit B.
6. **Affirmative Action.** In accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, all contracting entities must comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 et seq. Proposer is required to submit an Affirmative Action Statement together with evidence of compliance. Appendix A contains mandatory Affirmative Action Language which shall appear in any contract with the Township and which lists in subparagraph (j) thereof the acceptable documents that may be submitted to evidence compliance. Proposer must complete and submit the Affirmative Action Compliance Notice attached hereto as Exhibit C.
7. **Affidavit of Non-Collusion.** Proposer shall properly execute and submit the Affidavit of Non-Collusion attached hereto as Exhibit D.
8. **Pay to Play.** The successful proposer is advised of the responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement on political contributions with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.13 if the successful proposer receives contracts in excess of \$50,000 from public entities in a calendar year. It is the successful proposer's responsibility to determine if filing is necessary. See Exhibit E.
9. **Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.** Discrimination on the basis of disability in contracting for the purchase of goods and services is prohibited. Proposers are required to read Americans with Disabilities language attached to this RFP at Exhibit F and agree that the provisions of Title II of the Act are made a part of the contract. The successful Proposer will be obligated to comply with the Act and to hold the owner harmless.
10. **Protected Information.** By submission of the proposal, the proposer certifies that the service to be furnished will not infringe upon any valid patent, trademark or copyright and the successful proposer shall, at its expense, defend any and all actions or suits charging such infringement, and will save the Township harmless in any case of any such infringement.
11. **Signature Page.** Proposer shall complete and submit the signatory page attached as Exhibit G, which shall be signed by an authorized representative of the Proposer and evidence the Proposer's acceptance of the terms and conditions of this RFP.
12. **RFP Document Checklist.** Proposer must complete and submit the RFP Document Checklist attached hereto as Exhibit H.

EVALUATION CRITERIA AND BASIS FOR AWARD OF CONTRACT

The Township shall award all professional service agreements based upon qualifications, merit, references and experience with issues confronting the Township of West Caldwell. The specific evaluation criteria will include:

1. Firm experience and reputation;
2. Knowledge of the engineering services to be provided;
3. Availability to accommodate the meeting schedule and required needs of the Mayor and Council and the Township's Administrative Departments; and
4. Other factors the Mayor & Council deem to be in the best interest of the Township of West Caldwell and its taxpayers.

A final award shall be made by Resolution adopted by a majority of the Mayor and Council based upon the proposal made to the Township that has been determined to be **the most advantageous to the Township, all factors considered**. The Mayor and Council reserve the right to negotiate the terms and conditions with any qualified proposer before making its determination and appointment. All awards are and shall be subject to the availability of funds.

Appendix A

MANDATORY EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY LANGUAGE N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., N.J.A.C. 17:27

GOODS, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND GENERAL SERVICE CONTRACTS

Each contractor shall submit to the public agency, after notification of award but prior to execution of a goods and services contract, one of the following three documents:

Appropriate evidence that the contractor is operating under an existing Federally approved or sanctioned affirmative action program;

A certificate of employee information report approval, issued in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4; or

An employee information report (Form AA302) provided by the Division and distributed to the public agency to be completed by the contractor, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-4.

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the contractor will ensure that equal employment opportunity is afforded to such applicants in recruitment and employment, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Such equal employment opportunity shall include, but not limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union or representative or workers with which it has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer advising the labor union or workers' representative of the contractor's commitments under this act and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to **N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq.** as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to afford equal employment opportunities to minority and women workers consistent with good faith efforts to meet targeted county employment goals established in accordance with **N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2**, or good faith efforts to meet targeted county employment goals determined by the Division, pursuant to **N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2**.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing its appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedure, if necessary, to assure that all personal testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

In conforming with the targeted employment goals, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

The contractor and its subcontractor shall furnish such reports or other documents to the Division of Public Contracts Equal Employment Opportunity Compliance as may be requested by the Division from time to time in order to carry out the purposes of these regulations, and public agencies shall furnish such information as may be requested by the Division of Public Contracts Equal Employment Opportunity Compliance for conducting a compliance investigation pursuant to **Subchapter 10 of the Administrative Code at N.J.A.C. 17:27.**

The contractor and the Township of West Caldwell, (hereafter "owner") do hereby agree that the provisions of Title 11 of the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 (the "Act") (*42 U.S.C. § 12101 et seq.*), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by public entities in all services, programs, and activities provided or made available by public entities, and the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant there unto, are made a part of this contract. In providing any aid, benefit, or service on behalf of the owner pursuant to this contract, the contractor agrees that the performance shall be in strict compliance with the Act. In the event that the contractor, its agents, servants, employees, or subcontractors violate or are alleged to have violated the Act during the performance of this contract, the contractor shall defend the owner in any action or administrative proceeding commenced pursuant to this Act. The contractor shall indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner, its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages, of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of the alleged violation. The contractor shall, at its own expense, appear, defend, and pay any and all charges for legal services and any and all costs and other expenses arising from such action or administrative proceeding or incurred in connection therewith. In any and all complaints brought pursuant to the owner's grievance procedure, the contractor agrees to abide by any decision of the owner which is rendered pursuant to said grievance procedure. If any action or administrative proceeding results in an award of damages against the owner, or if the owner incurs any expense to cure a violation of the ADA which has been brought pursuant to its grievance procedure, the contractor shall satisfy and discharge the same at its own expense.

The owner shall, as soon as practicable after a claim has been made against it, give written notice thereof to the contractor along with full and complete particulars of the claim. If any action or administrative proceeding is brought against the owner or any of its agents, servants, and employees, the *owner shall* expeditiously forward or have forwarded to the contractor every demand, complaint, notice, summons, pleading, or other process received by the owner or its representatives.

It is expressly agreed and understood that any approval by the owner of the services provided by the contractor pursuant to this contract will not relieve the contractor of the obligation to comply with the Act and to defend, indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner pursuant to this paragraph.

It is further agreed and understood that the owner assumes no obligation to indemnify or save harmless the contractor, its agents, servants, employees and subcontractors for any claim which may arise out of their performance of this Agreement. Furthermore, the contractor expressly understands and agrees that the provisions of this indemnification clause shall in no way limit the contractor's obligations assumed in this Agreement, nor shall they be construed to relieve the contractor from any liability, nor preclude the owner from taking any other actions available to it under any other provisions of the Agreement or otherwise at law.
